Dedication of church in Petuake, Zambia



Two Churches in Zambia

This year we partnered with two villages to build two churches (Grace Baptist and Living Water Baptist) in the Petauke area of Zambia, where we have discipleship work established. Eddie Napps, Jared Sexton, and Dr. Glynn Stone traveled to Zambia to dedicate these two churches. The people were so thankful for the church buildings. There was also enough money to build nice toilet facilities for the churches. A big thanks goes both to all the individuals who gave to this project and the Crazy Big Mission Offering from Mobberly Baptist which allowed us to build these two key churches in Zambia.

Discipleship Courses

So far, we have distributed more than 50,000 discipleship course booklets. There are one thousand Bible centers run by those who have successfully completed the Level I course, and are now able to train others. About 5,000 booklets were shipped in this year, but many more are needed. This fall our Executive Director, Jared Sexton, spent a month traveling in Zambia teaching and supporting the discipleship leaders in this imperative work.

A Parallel English/Chichewa Bible

During the past year, Rick Carr has worked diligently to identify and secure a printer in Ethiopia who would print our Bibles, the first ever English/Chichewa parallel version. How can they grow in Christ without the Word? Various delays meant the first shipment of 972 Bibles arrived several days after our team left Malawi. At the present, we are waiting to get a few of them to the U.S. for editing purposes and approval to complete the remainder of the printings. Increased shipping costs raised the price of the Bibles by two dollars each above expected, so at this time each Bible costs \$5.50. Everyone we talked to in Malawi and Zambia is excitedly waiting for these Bibles to arrive. Thank you so much for all the help you have already given for this. We need to raise about \$7,000 to hit our goal of 5,000 Bibles printed and delivered.

The New Center for Discipleship and Leadership Excellence

Jericho Road Ministries has provided Bible courses to churches in the Lilongwe, Malawi area for a few years. In the past two years alone, 1200 new churches have been planted in Lilongwe because discipleship in local churches is working. Can you imagine trying to train pastors, Sunday School teachers, and deacons at this rate? The Center is a newly finished facility in Lilongwe that will allow us to multiply the number of qualified equippers many times over. This will also help us disciple people that are being saved in unreached language groups in Mozambique. Lilongwe pastors have been producing as many trained leaders as they could, yet today there are over 100,000 new believers waiting to be baptized! What a harvest field! Jericho Road Ministries Bible courses will be used at this Center to help train new leaders. Literally both soul winners and disciples must multiply in order to reach a population that has a life expectancy of 34.
