Parallel English/Chichewa Bible - More Copies of Courses Needed

Our first shipment of parallel English/Chichewa Bibles is being distributed in Zambia and Malawi. Rick Carr is in the process of searching and securing a place that is in Central or South Africa that can print the future shipments of this Bible, as well as possibly printing our Emmaus Bible Courses. With the need so great, locating a printing house that will reduce the cost of shipping will mean we can get the Bibles and courses in more quickly and use less of our funds just on shipping.

Discipleship Courses Pilot Project

A group study pilot project was begun a few months ago. This was born out of the great need due to the many new believers who want to study the Word and the need for translation from English to Chichewa. There are 4 groups in the Livingstone area of Zambia and 2 groups in Malawi. We are expecting the first graduation to be in late January or early February. There have already been many requests for more group studies. We are excited about this potential for teaching the Word in a hungry land. Please pray for more teachers to be developed to take more new groups. Please pray for the teachers we have now, Sililo Mushawa, Jaspa Mujuda and Mweyama Mulengwani. Please pray for the students in these groups, that they may grow in the Word and Spirit of God.

“Our Zone Coordinator, Pastor Field Zimba, had an opportunity to visit the Mumbwa Prison and introduce the Jericho Road discipleship courses to the prisoners. One of the prisoners, there since 2014, completed the courses and was recognized by the prison leadership for his hard work. He was promoted to be a leader and supervisor among his fellow prisoners. After being released from prison, he has continued to lead others through the discipleship courses.”

Ross Collier Memorial Gift

Our beloved Ross Collier, shown above, went to his eternal home a few months ago. He was a Jericho Road Board member after returning to the States from being a missionary in Malawi for 34 years. His heart was evangelism and church planting. Part of his vision to secure the future of that in Malawi was to coordinate the building of a training facility. He was able to see the dedication of the initial stage of the structure. Even though it is currently not finished out, it is being used for training. The Lilongwe Association has named it *The Ross Collier Leadership Training Center* (shown below). The Jericho Road Board is going to make a memorial donation to this Center to help finish the building. Rooms for pastors to stay overnight need to be furnished. The cost for one room is \$4,500.
