

## Work in Malawi

**M**obberly Baptist Church is partnering with leaders in Malawi to support a Pastor Training Center. McLean Chimwenje and George Katambo are the pastors leading this work in the Mitundu area. The initial group is finishing their first year of a two year program with 20 students. The plan is to start another group each year so there will be pastors trained and ready each year. Our Bible courses are being used with these pastors/leaders as they train. Their goal is to plant churches with these newly trained pastors. We will partner with them in providing our discipleship courses for these new church plants.

In February, graduations were held in Chipata, Kabwe, and the first group class in Livingstone. In September, graduations were held in Mwanjawanthu, New Jerusalem village, and Chipata. ## Report From Our Vice President

“I continue to be amazed by what God is doing in the hearts and lives of the precious people of Zambia and Malawi. What a privilege it is to have the opportunity to be there and see how God is using His Word by the power of His Holy Spirit to change lives. This year, in September, we again had the privilege of partnering with Mobberly Baptist Church of Longview, TX. We were able to travel to the Petuake area of Zambia where Jericho Road has been involved for several years in discipling through our courses. Mobberly was able to bring both a medical team and an evangelistic team. Several days of medical clinics brought much needed help to the Petuake area. Teams also went hut to hut with the Gospel message in several villages. The Jesus film was also shown at these villages, with a new church being planted.

While Mobberly's team was busy with their work, I had the opportunity to go with my wife, Cindy, as well as our Zambian leaders Bro. Dickson and Bro. Mweyama to visit areas where Jericho Road has ministry. First we attended a church service and graduation in Mwanjawanthu village. Bro. Soko

is the pastor and our area coordinator. Pastor Jay Shepherd from Mobberly brought a message to this church. The next day, we had meetings with Hope Baptist Church, which was planted a year ago, for the purpose of growing the discipleship ministry there. The next day, we traveled to the Chipata area, meeting with the local Chief, and attending the graduations at New Jerusalem village and Chipata. While at Chipata, Cindy was able to share with the ladies and encourage them in studying the Word. The last day, we traveled further into the Eastern Province. In Chipangali, we met with church leaders about beginning

## Printing of Old Testament

We received our first shipment of Old Testaments early in 2018. This now makes our Bible available in English/Chichewa complete. When someone graduates Level I courses, they receive a New Testament. If they choose to begin Level II courses, which are much more extensive, they will receive an Old Testament to use in their studies. Having a printing facility in Zambia has been such a blessing and will help tremendously in making the courses and Bibles available in the future without shipping costs.
